



## **About Camano Island and the Mosquito Control District**

The Camano Island Mosquito Control District Manager position is a unique opportunity to work in a beautiful environment and a great community. We are the only Mosquito Control District in the greater Puget Sound area so your knowledge of mosquito control will be highly regarded. Camano is about 50 miles north of Seattle and is one of the few islands in Puget Sound that does not require a ferry ride on and off the island. The mosquito control district does not cover all of Camano Island and encompasses approximately 8 square miles. The management position is a work from home setting with a small portable office. It has a desk and computer work area, a workbench with lab equipment; microscope, magnifying glass, digital microscope, RAMP West Nile Virus test unit. We rent a storage unit to house all our equipment.

The district also owns and operates two UAS units (Drones). We have a DJI Phantom 4 Pro that we use for scouting and water surveillance and a larger drone Precision Vision 13 that we use to apply larvicides to larger and hard to reach areas. For hauling equipment and supplies on long treks we have an Electric Power Wagon that can carry up to 500 lbs. You will also have the use of the district pickup at your disposal for district activities.

We are a well-established organization, however; you will have the opportunity to work independently and establish your preferred goals in the work environment. There's still plenty of work to do with an opportunity to expand your knowledge and skills.

Camano Island has several shopping and dining establishments and with Stanwood nearby, the shopping and dining opportunities are numerous and diverse. The Stanwood Camano School District is a great district for the kids.
